THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, HIGHER EDUCATION AND TECHNICAL PROFESSIONAL (MCTESTP) AND FINANCIAL SECTOR DEEPENING MOZAMBIQUE (FSDMOÇ) PROMOTE A DIGITAL CITIZEN

The Network of Institutions of Higher Education and Research of Mozambique (MORENET) and Financial Sector Deepening Mozambique (DAI/FSDMoç), Institution dedicated to the promotion of Financial Inclusion, signed today 29 January of the current year, at MCTESTP's premises in Maputo, a Memorandum of Understanding that establishes the general terms of the cooperation between the two institutions in the context of the implementation of a Digital Citadel in a closed environment.

The Memorandum was signed by Dr. Eng, Lourino Chemane, Executive Director of MoRENet, representing the Ministry of Science and Technology, Higher Education and Professional Technician, and the Executive Director Prof. Dr. Esselina Macome, representing DAI/FSDMoç. promotion of inclusion through the creation of an Electronic Identification System that will facilitate access to teaching and research content in addition to other MoRENet value added services such as: banking transactions, access to bank credit, Internet services, credit granting and other academic services, space for storing data, which allows, at any time, new financial transaction functionalities to be incorporated, without the need to exchange cards or mobile electronic identification devices.

This MoU intends to start with the implementation of MoRENet's Electronic Identification System, including the development of its respective information systems, smart card supply services and database for MoRENet's online transaction processing systems.

The ultimate goal is to enable Morenet members to make digital transactions using the unique digital identifier which will facilitate the identification of their members thus avoiding instances of duplication of benefits at the level of the academic community, the public sector, the private sector, research centers and beneficiaries concerned.
