### Public notice – FSD Moçambique (FSDMoç) in limited operations amid COVID-19 pandemic

In light of the Global COVID-19 pandemic and its spread and impact in Mozambique and in compliance with directives from the Government and health Authorities on preventative measures such as social distancing, and also thinking on the safety and well-being of our staff members, partners and stakeholders, FSD Moçambique has decided that from 26<sup>th</sup> March 2020 our office will be closed and our staff will work remotely. This will be for an undetermined period and we will be updated as soon as more guidelines are provided by the Mozambican Government and other official sources.
